Magpie in the Garden by Abbey Hombsch

Year 9 Textiles and Design have each designed and made a textiles art piece based on the theme "In the garden". Each piece needed to include the use of four or more decorative techniques in a creative manner. Abbey Hombsch made an attractive, well-constructed piece titled "Magpie in the Garden".

"I got inspiration from nature, gardens, garden magazines and my own back garden.

The focus piece of my panel is the asymmetrical magpie. The magpie stands out because of its black and white against the coloured background.

Rhythm occurs in my panel through repetition of birds in the sky which is balanced by the lavender plant with the magpie. The texture is soft, fluffy and is raised off the fabric.

The colours used are bright, cheerful and are cool coloured but also I have used shades. Shapes used are curved, long triangles and organic shapes to get a realistic effect. I have used straight, diagonal and curvy lines." By Abbey Hombsch
